With reference to above cited subject, I am directed to communicate that, as per the University laid down procedure & your proposal for Continuation of Affiliation & / or Extension of Affiliation, the Hon'ble Academic Council is pleased to grant Conditional Continuation of Affiliation & / or Extension of Affiliation for Academic Year 2025-26 as per the provision u/s 68 and 65(4) of the MUHS Act, 1998, for the Under Graduate BHMS Course of your College with Intake Capacity of 60 seats subject to the permission granted by Central Government / National Commission for Homoeopathy / State Government (as applicable).

Following deficiencies shall be strictly complied within Thirty Days, from the date of receipt of this letter.

(vii) Settlement of advance(s) / dues of any section of the University including affiliation fees if pending with the College and any other deficiency observed by any regulating authority, please submit within 03 (three) months, otherwise, no action will be taken on teacher's proposal for approval / PG Recognition received from your College.

Important Note:

- 1) This Conditional Continuation / Extension of affiliation is issued for the A.Y. 2025-2026 subject to the permission of National Commission for Homoeopathy / Government of India/Department of AYUSH, New Delhi. Further, if the permission is declined by the said authorities, this Conditional Continuation / Extension of Affiliation shall be treated as cancelled. The College is not authorized to admit students for 1st Year of the course until receipt of permission of the National Commission for Homoeopathy / Government of India /Department of AYUSH, New Delhi.
- 2) The admission shall be done through the Competent Authorities only.

Sangali, Maharashtra- 416405 for Admission in BHMS Undergraduate Course with Intake Capacity of 60 seats for academic year 2025-26 – reg.

Sir/Madam,

Nootan Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital has submitted an application for permission for sanction of 60 seats in BHMS course for academic year 2025-26. The College has submitted the Part I information in which the entire functional profile has been narrated. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board (MARBH) has conducted inspection on 18.06.2025 and 19.06.2025, followed by virtual hearing on 02.07.2025. MARBH has examined the profile of the College as to whether the college fulfils the Minimum Essential Standards 2024 as per the prevailing regulations under clauses 26 and 28 of the NCH Act 2020. On careful examination of the report, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board observed the following shortfalls: -

1. Deficiency of Teaching Faculty (10 deficiencies)

- Department of Anatomy: One Professor, One Associate Professor are not available.
- Department of Physiology and Biochemistry: One Associate Professor is not available
- Department of Organon of Medicine and Homoeopathic Philosophy and fundamentals of Psychology: One Professor is not available.
- Department of Pathology: One Professor is not available.
- Department of Practice of Medicines with essentials of pharmacology: One Professor, One Associate Professor are not available.
- Department of Gynecology & Obstetrics: One Associate Professor is not available.
- Department of Community Medicine and Research Methodology: One Professor is not available.
- Department of Repertory and Case Taking: One Professor is not available.

As evident from the above statement, a total number of 10 UG teachers are deficient against the requirement of 40 + 1 for 60 seats UG college (As specified in MES, 2024). Pursuant to F.No.:3-2/MARBH/NCH/2025-26/162-169 dated 16/04/2025 issued by MARBH, a college can avail 15% relaxation against the required number of teachers for Academic Year 2025-26 only. After allowing relaxation of 15%, college has 04 deficiency of teacher. However, such relaxed number of teachers may be appointed at the earliest for smooth conduct of course.

2. Miscellaneous:

- NABL accreditation for clinical laboratory not done.

3. Considering the above observations during inspection and hearing, MARBH has decided to issue **Conditional permission to Nootan Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital, Gat No. 412, Landgewadi, Tal. Kavathemahankal, Dist. Sangli, Maharashtra- 416405 for continuing UG (BHMS) course with intake capacity of 60 seats for academic year 2025-26, on the basis of following conditions: -**


- a) NABL accreditation for clinical laboratory to be done.
- b) One Professor in Department of Anatomy to be appointed.
- c) One Professor in Department of Organon of Medicine to be appointed.
- d) One Professor in Department of Pathology to be appointed.
- e) One Professor in Department of Repertory to be appointed.

The institute will rectify all the above deficiencies within a month and compliance shall be submitted to MARBH, failing which permission may be withdrawn.

4. All admissions shall be made from NEET qualified candidates only. It is further informed that minimum 15% of seats of the permitted intake capacity of BHMS course shall be treated as All India Quota. Counseling for seats under All India Quota shall be conducted by Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling authority of the state/UT designated by Central Government. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government for All India Quota or the student admitted thereunder.
5. The Category wise list of the selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board.
