Admission in Nootan Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital, Gat No.412, Landgewadi, Tal. Kavathemahankal, Dist. Sangali-416405, Maharashtra for continuing admissions in 1-BHMS course 60 seats for the academic session 2021-22-reg.

Ref: - Ministry of AYUSH letter No. 14011/3/2021-EP(II) (Pt.) dated 26.03.2021. Central Council for Homoeopathy Letter no.15-8/2020 CCH (Part) (Visitation matter)/743-744 dated 16.04.2021.

As Central Government by notification, constituted a Commission, to be known as Sir, the National Commission for Homoeopathy, to exercise the powers conferred upon, and to perform the functions assigned to it, under NCH Act 2020. As per section 59 (2) of NCH Act, 2020, following has been stated:

"Notwithstanding the repeal of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act 1973, the educational and medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and the rules and regulations made thereunder shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made thereunder: Provided that anything done or any action taken as regards the educational and medical standards and requirements under the enactment under repeal and the rules and regulations made thereunder shall be deemed to have been done or taken under the corresponding provision of this Act and shall continue in force accordingly unless and until superseded by anything or by any action taken under this Act".

As per provision in the Act, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy has been constituted with the mandate to grant permission to the existing and new medical institution of Homoeopathy. Accordingly, it is to inform you that all the relevant documents submitted by your college in Part-1 proforma were examined by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board.

2. On careful consideration of the report, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board has arrived at the following conclusion:-

That the applicant has set up a Homoeopathic Medical College with the component of staff, infrastructure, equipment and instruments and other facilities where as the College has to take certain time bound steps to implement Minimum Standard Requirements of the Homoeopathy College and attached Hospital as prescribed by the National Commission for Homoeopathy for conducting BHMS course in Homoeopathy.

A. Hospital staff: Gynecologist not available as required.

B. Teaching Faculty:

- i. The College has provided list of 12 Guest faculties out of which none considered eligible as previous experience not provided.
- ii. Part time teachers of Modern Medicine are not available. The College has filled 05 part time teachers in Part 1, but no document is provided for the verification.
- C. Miscellaneous: Form 16 of only Dr Bajirao Appa provided.
- D. **Website**: https://www.nootanhmch.com / Student's data is not available as checked on 06/09/2021 and website last updated on 07/04/2021.
- 3. After considering the provisions of section 12C (1) of Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013, permission of the Medical Assessment and Rating Board is issued to Nootan Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital, Gat No.412, Landgewadi, Tal. Kavathemahankal, Dist. Sangali-416405, Maharashtra for 60 seats in 1-BHMS course for the academic session year 2021-22. The College Principal is directed to fulfill the deficiencies within three months and an affidavit in this regard may be submitted to the Medical Assessment Board within a period of one week.
- 4. All admissions in Under Graduate course shall be through NEET only. It is further informed that, minimum 15% of seats of the permitted intake capacity of BHMS course shall be treated as All India quota. The counseling for seats under All India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling Authority of State / UT Government as designated by the Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling Authority of that State / UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government for All India quota or the student admitted thereunder.
- 5. The category wise list of selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board as per rules.
- 6. The college has to comply with the full requirements of Minimum Standard Requirement Regulations, 2013 for conducting the course. All deficiencies observed and mentioned above which affects the performance of the academic Institution, through which College fails to fulfill the statutory requirements, has to be rectified within three months time from issue of this permission letter. Compliance report shall be submitted by the college to Medical Assessment and Rating Board accordingly. Subsequently, the Board shall verify the compliance well in time and may conduct Online/Physical inspection for verification of compliance as per the HCC (MSR) Regulation, 2013 and will consider admissions for the academic year 2022-23

- 1) The Continuation / Extension of Affiliation is issued for the Academic Year 2021-2022 subject to the permission of National Commission for Homoeopathy/Central Council of Homoeopathy, New Delhi/Govt. of India/Department of AYUSH, New Delhi and if the permission is declined by the said authorities this Continuation / Extension of Affiliation shall be treated as cancelled. The college is not authorized to admit the students for 1<sup>st</sup> year of the course until receipt of permission of the National Commission for Homoeopathy, New Delhi/Govt. of India/Department of AYUSH, New Delhi.
- 2) The admission shall be done only through the Competent Authorities.
